Moderator & Trainer: Mag. Dr. Thomas Pfeffer

The trainer and moderator for our next Train-the-Faculty Workshop will be Mag. Dr. Thomas Pfeffer who is a researcher, educator and consultant for Higher Education Policy and Management. He did his Master of Social and Economic Sciences at the University of Vienna in 1999 and his PhD at the University of Klagenfurt in 2007. In his thesis he laid the focus on the "Virtualisation of Universities. Digital Media and the Organisation of Higher Education Institutions".

As an expert in the field of Higher education quality, evaluation and accreditation and with his research interest in knowledge and literacy as global public goods and ICT in research and higher education, he will be an enrichment in moderating the discussions that should lead us to the development of a Media Literacy programme structure. A structure that should be the foundation for our MOOC/s (Massive Open Online Course).

Mag. Dr. Thomas Pfeffer is part of another Erasmus+ Capacity Building Project within his role as a research fellow at the Department for Migration and Globalisation at the Danube-University Krems. The BInUCom-Project - Building Inclusive Urban Communities — started its 3-years runtime in October 2015 and aims to professionalize the education of architectures and urban planners in India. Another Erasmus+ Capacity Building Project, where he will participate in a leading role starts soon.

External Expert: Dr. Ibarhim Saleh

Another guest that has been invited to join the workshop in Kuala Lumpur is Dr. Ibrahim Saleh from Cairo, who will be there in his role as external expert to improve the project's quality. He will evaluate the work already done during the last months, talk to the project partners and write in the end a quality report to help us improve the project's quality.



By not only being an expert in the field of communication and media studies but also neighbouring fields, Dr. Saleh provides an external view on our project and the internal processes.

Additionally, he will give us an insight into one of his fields of expertise: Journalism Education. He was holding the Chair of the IAMCR-section Journalism Research & Education (JRE) until the beginning of 2016.

Dr. Ibrahim Saleh is an Associate Professor at Nile University in Egypt now, after having taught at the American University of Cairo and the Centre for Film and Media Studies in Cape Town.

He is a senior expert in Media Sustainability Index (MSI).

Amongst a variety of articles, Dr. Ibrahim Saleh has published four books: "Visual Politics of War", "Transnational Worlds of Power: Proliferation of Journalism and Professional Standards", "Unveiling the Truth About Middle Eastern Media. Privatization in Egypt: Hope or Dope?", and "Prior to the Eruption of Grapes in the Middle East: The Necessity of Communicating Instead of Clashing".





The Workshop Idea

The purpose of the MEDLIT-Workshop Higher Education is to discuss the practical implications Media Literacy has for the Asian partners of the MEDLIT-project, especially focusing on how to foster Media Literacy in the study programmes at their Higher Education Institutions.

The workshop wants to shift the focus of the conversation in the MEDLIT-project from the theoretical approach to the strategic interests of the project partners. The aim of the workshop is to determine which already existing modules in the study programmes could be combined with the preliminary findings of the Delphi Study to find the best levers for a joint Media Literacy programme structure. For this purpose, it will be necessary to develop a better understanding of the local programmes and needs.

Additionally, the workshop aims at developing a joint understanding of the products the MEDLIT project should produce. The workshop will be executed by mixing plenary sessions and smaller work group sessions.

By the end of the workshop we should have a concept for the content-related structures of the Media Literacy programme and the MOOC/s, that should be refined and processed during the following project activities.

Preparing for the Workshop

We would kindly ask you to prepare a presentation of the media-related study programme/s at your home university for our discussion on Wednesday, November 23rd.

Presentation of Study Programmes (by each Asian HEI):

Please present the media related study programme/s at your Home University that should profit from the MEDLIT project. Use the following dimensions:

- Name and level (bachelor, master, PhD) of the study programme
- Profession, occupational field, qualification profile of graduates
- Relevance of media literacy for the specific study programme (its occupational field)
- Structural information (e.g. duration of programme, number of students, student/teacher ratio, other specific characteristics, etc.)

Ideally think about what would a lecturer / a faculty member have to know about the study programme/s to maximize the impact of their teaching and benefit using the synergetic potentials of the curriculum.

Each HEI has 20 minutes for presentation & 10 minutes for Q&A / please prepare a Handout
